## OUR MISSION

We aim to improve the life prospects of all people of Tanzania by providing safe, sustainable water and health education in partnership with local communities.

## WHY TANZANIA?

During trips to Tanzania over the past decade and more, lay groups from St. Paul area churches observed firsthand the tremendous need for safe, clean water and for hygiene and sanitation training. In Tanzania, 44% of the population gets their water from unprotected sources. Most of the water gathering is done by women and children. The lay groups organized and incorporated St. Paul Partners, a Minnesota nonprofit with an IRS 501(c)(3) tax designation, to assist in meeting those water needs.



## MISSION PARTNERS

Saint Paul Partners has been blessed with many valuable strategic partnerships. With organizations like Winter Wheat, the University of Minnesota and the US Embassy in Dar es Salaam, Saint Paul Partners is able to design and fund larger water systems by leveraging these partnerships. And our partnership with fellow Minnesota organization H2O For Life helps to fund water systems at Tanzanian schools, allowing school children in America to help school children in Tanzania. Ninety six University of Minnesota engineering students have traveled to Tanzania to design water systems as part of the travel abroad class "Design for Life". Completed systems now provide clean and safe water to more than 17,000 Tanzanians!

## WHAT YOUR GIFTS CAN DO

- Exploratory meeting with village officials regarding water/hygiene: \$150
- Training in hygiene – one village or school: \$250
- Sustainable water for one family: \$100
- Repair a hand pump: \$200
- Purchase a hand pump: \$1200
- Shallow well in one village: \$5,200
- Deep well (e.g. 100m) with submersible pump: \$12,000-\$15,000
- One month of overhead supporting TZ operations (2 employees): \$700
